

Rubric for Alabama Women During WWII Writing Assignment

Directions: Students should select an Alabama woman profiled in one of the articles and write a descriptive story or a newspaper article about her life during WWII. Students can be creative and include some details not found in the articles that would be appropriate for the time. Along with their writing assignment, students should provide an illustration that is colorful, neat, and compliments their story.
