

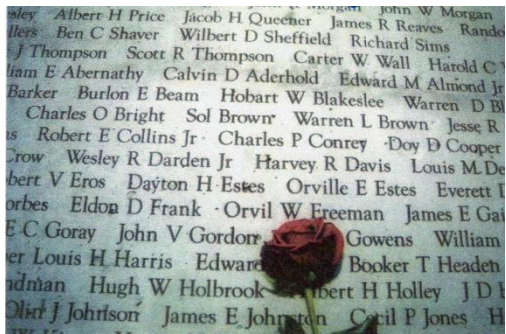
# The Alabama Veterans Memorial Park

Memorial Trail, Memorial Plaza, Hall of Honor

The Alabama Veterans Memorial Park is a 22 acre park that honors all veterans. At the end of the 1000 foot Memorial Trail that winds through beautiful woods, is a special outdoor memorial that honors Alabama veterans. The Memorial Plaza holds 36 magnificent twenty-foot columns that have embedded castings of Alabama Medal of Honor Recipients' citations; Alabama artists' work depicting war, sacrifice, peace and freedom; and, letters and telegrams from Alabama veterans.



Adjacent to the Memorial Plaza is the Hall of Honor. On the Hall of Honor walls are listed the names of over 11,000 veterans who were killed in conflict in the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries. The veterans' names are listed by conflict and alphabetized under their Alabama county of enlistment.
